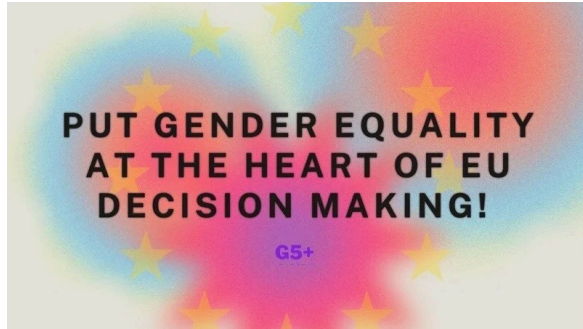

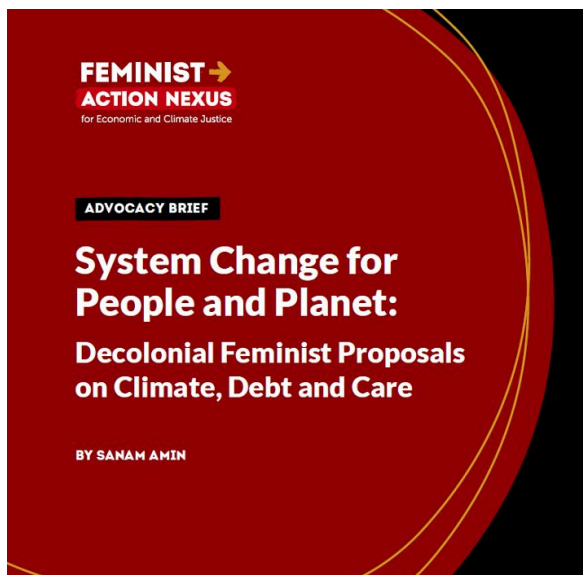
## G5+ has launched petition for gender equality under the EU Commission

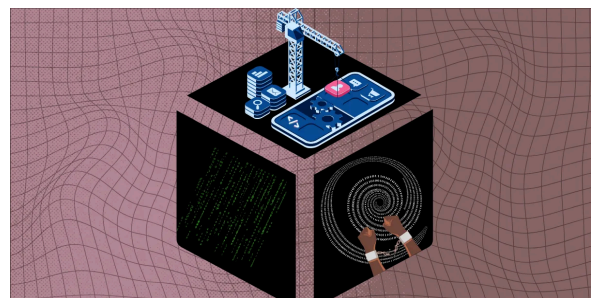
## IOM Gender Equality Policy 2024
