## Dear WIDE+ members and partners from across Europe,

As 2024 comes to a close, we want to express our gratitude for your dedication and contribution to a feminist, just, and sustainable tomorrow. This year has been one of both challenges and meaningful progress, and your passion and hard work continue to drive change.

In 2024, we worked together on:

- **Addressing AI and discrimination through FINDHR**, engaging in transnational dialogues and meetings, organising online courses and masterclasses, and raising awareness about the complex intersections between AI and multi-layered discrimination and biases.
- **Promoting safer online spaces** through the CB4VOL international campaign under the hashtags #SafeHerNet and #RespectfulClicks, with a focus on youth and young women.
- **Empowering migrant women in political and democratic life** through the WE-EMPOWER project, hosting numerous online and physical events in Europe, culminating in the last event on 21 November in Brussels: *Empower, Protect, Represent: Eliminating Barriers for Migrant Women in Politics*.
- **Amplifying feminist perspectives in climate change and climate policies** through COPGendered, publishing a series of briefing papers, hosting numerous events and calling for transformative climate solutions that centre justice, equality, and intersectionality.
- **Advocating for feminist trade policies**, supporting key initiatives, advocating for women in their plurality, workers and migrants, and signing numerous open letters challenging neoliberal policies, reaffirming our stance for a more equitable and just global economic framework.

This is just a glimpse of the work we've accomplished together in 2024. As we enter 2025, we reaffirm our commitment to fostering solidarity, intersectionality, and feminist resistance in the face of the multilayered crises that we currently are witnessing in Europe.
