In this webinar, you will explore **the roots of climate and gender inequality**: from how climate impacts are distributed across genders, to how feminist perspectives shape policy and community responses!

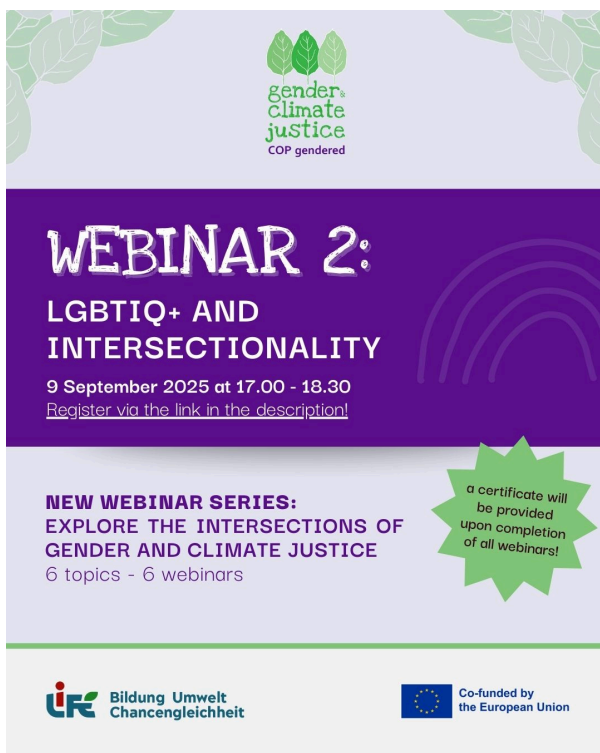
Hear from Gea Meijers and Kerime Van Opijnen, sharing case studies from their own region that reveal the structural links between environmental degradation and gender injustice.
